The meeting was called to order at 3:32 p.m.

2. Review and Action 2025 Events and Budget: City Administrator Karl Warwick provided an overview of the 2025 special events and budget, including Live at the Oasis, Fourth of July Celebration, Touch a Truck, Rhythm Nights, and 75th Anniversary Events.

- a. Live at the Oasis. The Committee reviewed the proposed musical lineup for the Live at the Oasis, beginning June 18th and ending August 6th with a total performance cost of \$13,000. The Committee concurred with the selected musical acts.
- b. Touch a Truck. The Committee concurred with the Disc Jockey and Karaoke for Touch a Truck on June 8th.
- c. Summer Rhythm Nights. The Committee directed Terrell Mathis to review options for Summer Rhythm Nights and bring recommendations at the next meeting.
- d. Independence Celebration (July 4th) @ Kletzsch Park. Jessica Ballweg provided an update on the event's planning. The Committee concurred with Judson Brown as the music performer at a cost of \$2,500 and agreed to continue with the event like past years. There was a general discussion on increasing volunteers for the event.
- e. Jazz and Soul. The Committee agreed to Marcus Adams as the performer for the August 16th event.
- f. 75th Anniversary Events. The Committee reviewed various events for the City's 75th Anniversary celebration. The Committee discussed a Run/Walk/Bike Glendale event on May 17th, possibly including giveaways, popup performances, dog parades, exercise challenges, and having local bike shops involved. The Committee directed Karl Warwick and Mustafa Emir to review options for the next Committee Meeting. The Committee discussed a Pride/Music/Juneteenth event on June 21st to include musical acts and events. Shawn Storey, Tomika Vukovic, Teresa Drews, and Terrell Mathis agreed to review options for the event to review at the next meeting. The Committee agreed to host a Halloween event on October 25th at Kletzsch Park. The Committee directed Karl Warwick, Jessica Ballweg and Becca Garrison to bring back further ideas to the Committee.

3. Consideration of Other Activities. The Committee discussed various other activities such as cornhole and kickball leagues.

- g. Adjournment: Motion by Becca Garrison, seconded by Jessica Ballweg, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
