## Plant Types

### Definition

Landscaping must be planted at the base of free standing and monument signs. One hundred (100) square feet of plantings must be placed at the base of signs identifying 1-2 tenant centers. Two hundred fifty (250) square feet of plantings must be placed at the base of a master identification sign identifying a multiple tenant center.
